**About the TPF Garden Share Network:** The Garden Share Network (GSN) is a collaboration between TPF and our supporters to expand the Foundation's living collection, increase horticultural knowledge about California's unique and diverse flora, and grow plants from seeds and cuttings collected from the gardens of our dedicated customers.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Garden must be in Los Angeles County
- Garden must be at least three years old
- Garden must contain some species or cultivars that are uncommon and/or not currently in TPF's living collection **and/or** garden must have space for new plants
- Garden access for TPF staff (upon request and coordinated with homeowner)

### **Benefits**

- Free seeds or stock plants, as they become available
- Credit for a propagation or seed-sowing class at the Foundation

### **Application Process**

Once your application has been reviewed, you will be contacted to schedule a garden visit.

Following the garden visit, you will be notified whether your garden has been accepted. Please understand that it may not be possible for us to accept every garden. If your garden is not accepted, we will keep your application on file for future consideration.

### **Agreement**

By participating in this program, you agree to coordinate periodic access to your garden (at your convenience) by TPF staff for the purposes of obtaining cuttings and/or seed.

Approved GSN sites will be included in a database, allowing us to match gardens with our seed and plant inventory. Information about GSN garden owners and locations will not be shared with any outside parties.

By accepting TPF stock plants, participants acknowledge that we may know very little about a particular plant and how it will perform in a garden setting. We will give you the best information we have but cannot guarantee a plant's success.
